Vision: By 2030, PNOC has provided vital energy resource/development and energy infrastructure, conducive to a clean environment and balanced and sustainable economic growth.



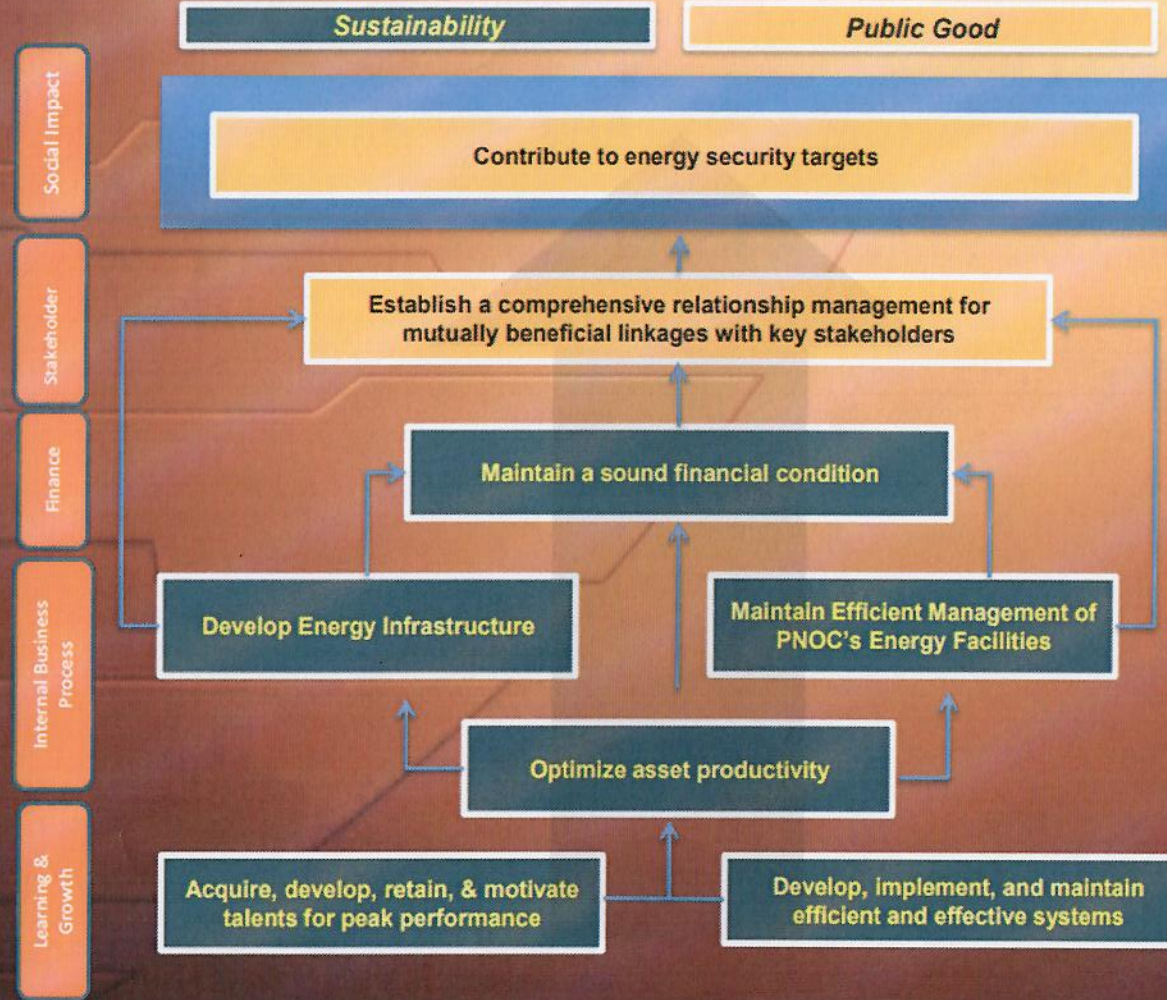




