PRICE QUOTATION / PROPOSAL AND COMPLIANCE FORM

TERMS OF REFERENCE DISMANTLING AND REPAIR OF TRANSFER PUMP AT PNOC BUILDING 6

SCOPE OF WORKS:

- 1. Conduct inspection and site evaluation prior to start of work.
- 2. Coordinate with PNOC representative for power service disconnection if necessary.
- 3. Dismantling, hauling and pull-out of defective unit for shop repair.
- 4. Evaluate, Disassemble, re-build and machining.
- 5. Machining of bearings housing prior to bearing replacement if necessary.
- 6. Replace all unit bearings.
- 7. Replace shaft seal and gaskets
- 8. Lubricating/greasing of mechanism.
- 9. Re-assemble the transfer pump with replace gaskets/seal and make certain that inside components are complete and duly cleaned.
- 10. Conduct no-load test run.
- 11. Re-paint (Standard) transfer pump unit as existing body color.
- 12. Delivery and re-installation of the unit.
- 13. Replace corroded transfer pump suction pipe at cistern tank.
- 14. Testing and commissioning.
- 15. Return waste materials to PNOC.
- 16. Demobilization of personnel, tools and equipments.

LABOR REQUIREMENT/S:

- Provide skilled electrical technicians, supervising personnel to include materials, safety kits, standard tools and calibrated test instruments.
- Bidder should be an electrical, mechanical or pump motor supplier and installer or repair contractor.

OTHER DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENT/S:

Submit at-least Two (2) satisfactorily completed pump motor supply and
installation or repair project. As proof, Bidder must submit certification issued by
the client (NOA, NTP, PO/Contract, or Certificate of completion) to attest to the
satisfactory service rendered by the contractor.

COMPLETION OF WORK:

Work should be completed in twenty (21) calendar days.

NOTE: Delays due to work stoppage ordered by GSD shall not be counted against the set completion date.

WARRANTY PROVISIONS:

All equipment, materials and workmanship shall be guaranteed for a period of six (6) months from date of acceptance. At any time within the period of guarantee and upon notification, the contractor shall repair and/or rectify all the deficiencies, including replacement of parts or entire unit, at the sole option of PNOC and without cost to PNOC.
